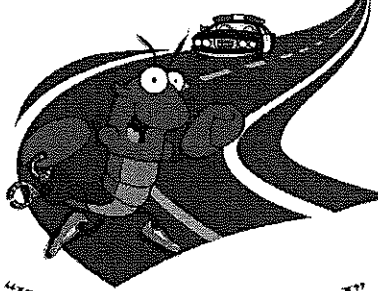

# CrimeStoppers 5K Mudbug Run/Walk

**When:** April 22, 2017 at 8:00 AM

**Where:** Uptown Station FWB, Florida

**Course:** Starts on Hughes St. heading towards Ferry Rd. At Walton Dr. turn left onto Walton Dr. At Yacht Club Dr. turn left onto Yacht Club Dr. Follow Yacht Club Drive to Nebraska Ave. Turn left onto Nebraska Ave. then turn left onto Clements St. Turn right onto Graham Cr. When Graham Cr. And Oregon Dr. intersect you will turn around and follow this course in reverse until you come to the back entrance to Uptown Station behind Buffalo Wild Wings. Finish Line will be here.

**Awards:** All awards will be presented at Uptown Station. Overall male/female, master male/female and grandmaster for the 5K Run/Walk. Awards will be presented to the top 3 male and female runners in the following age groups:  
5-9, 10-14, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70+

**Walking:** winners include: overall male and female adult(over 18) and overall male and female juvenile (under 18)
